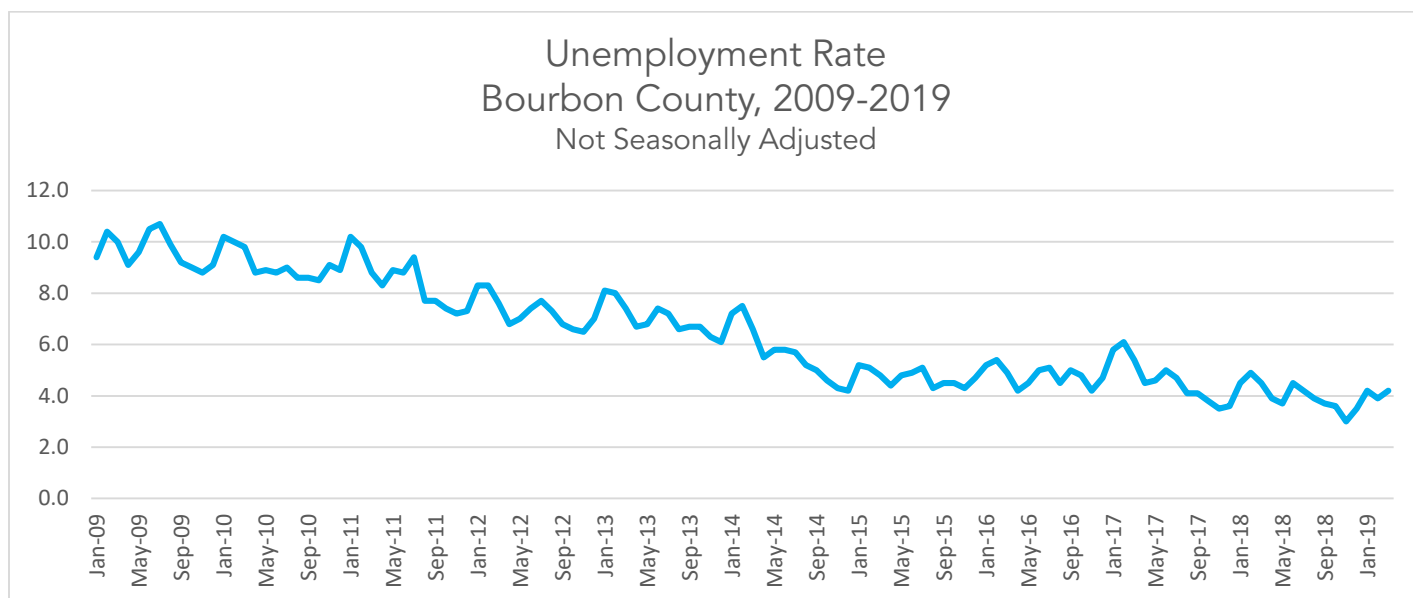

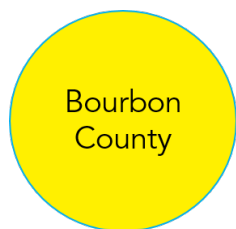
Unemployment Rate

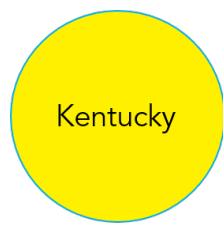
Labor Force Participation Rate

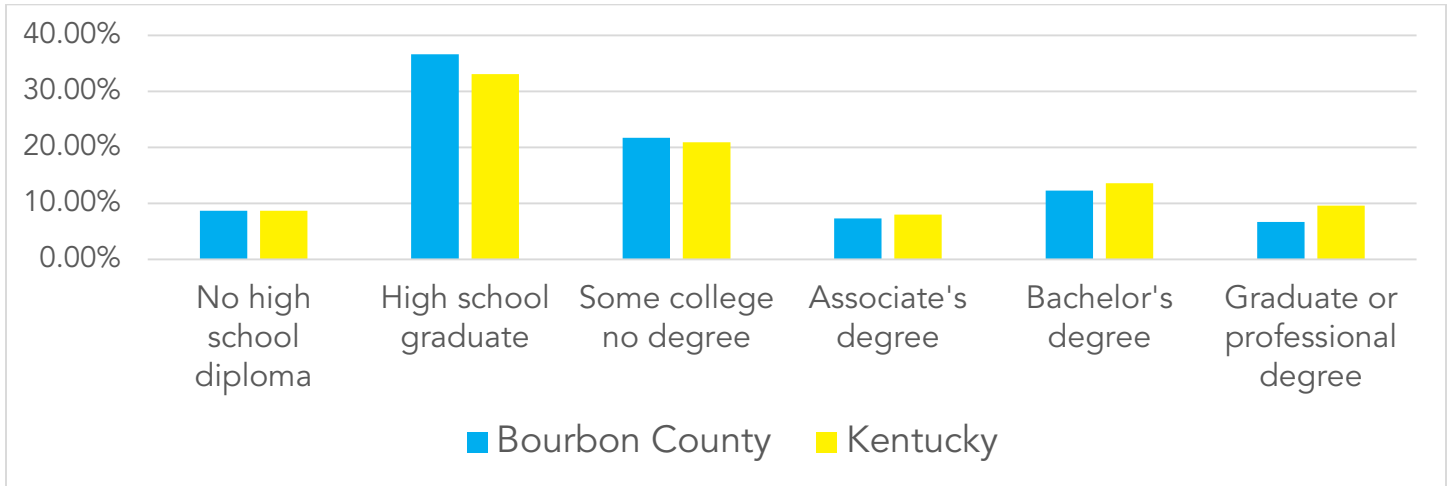

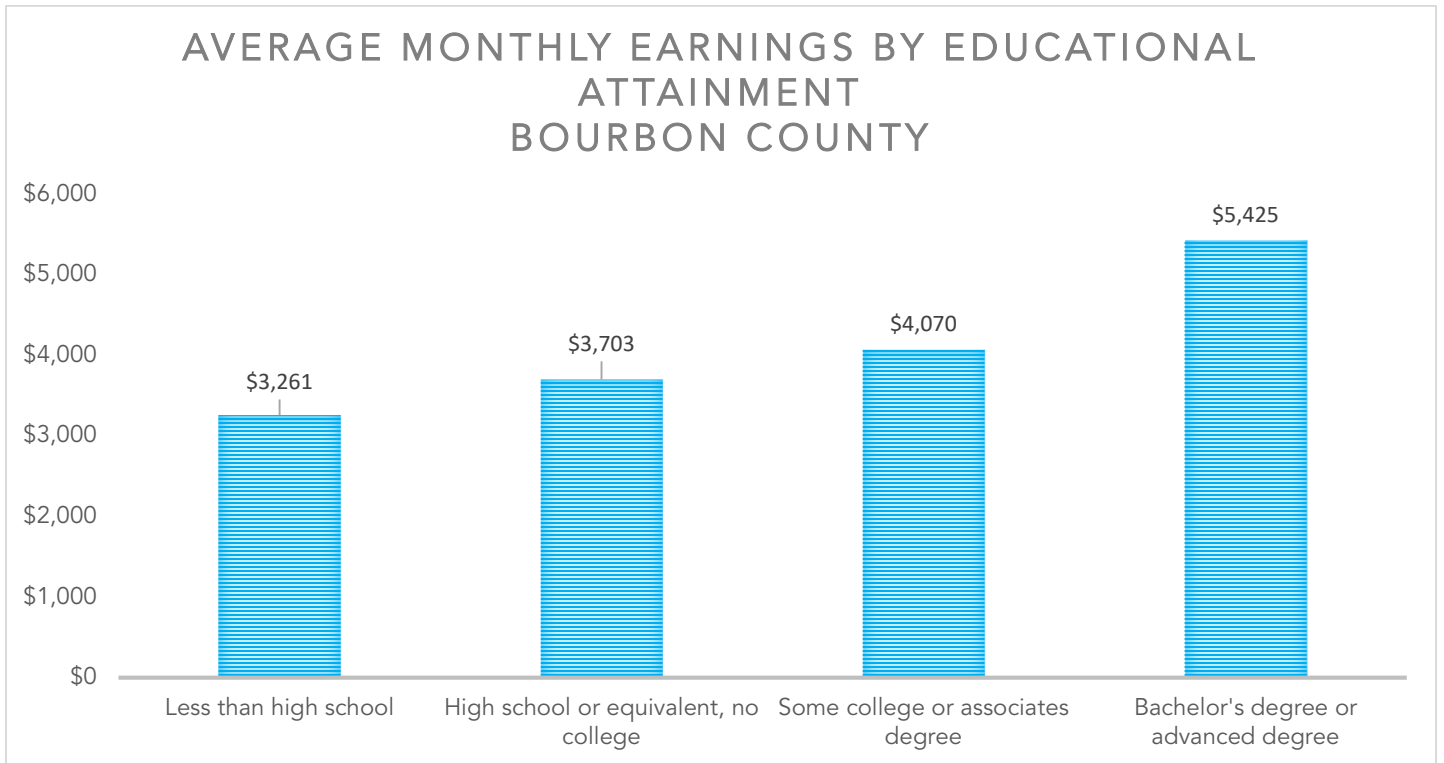

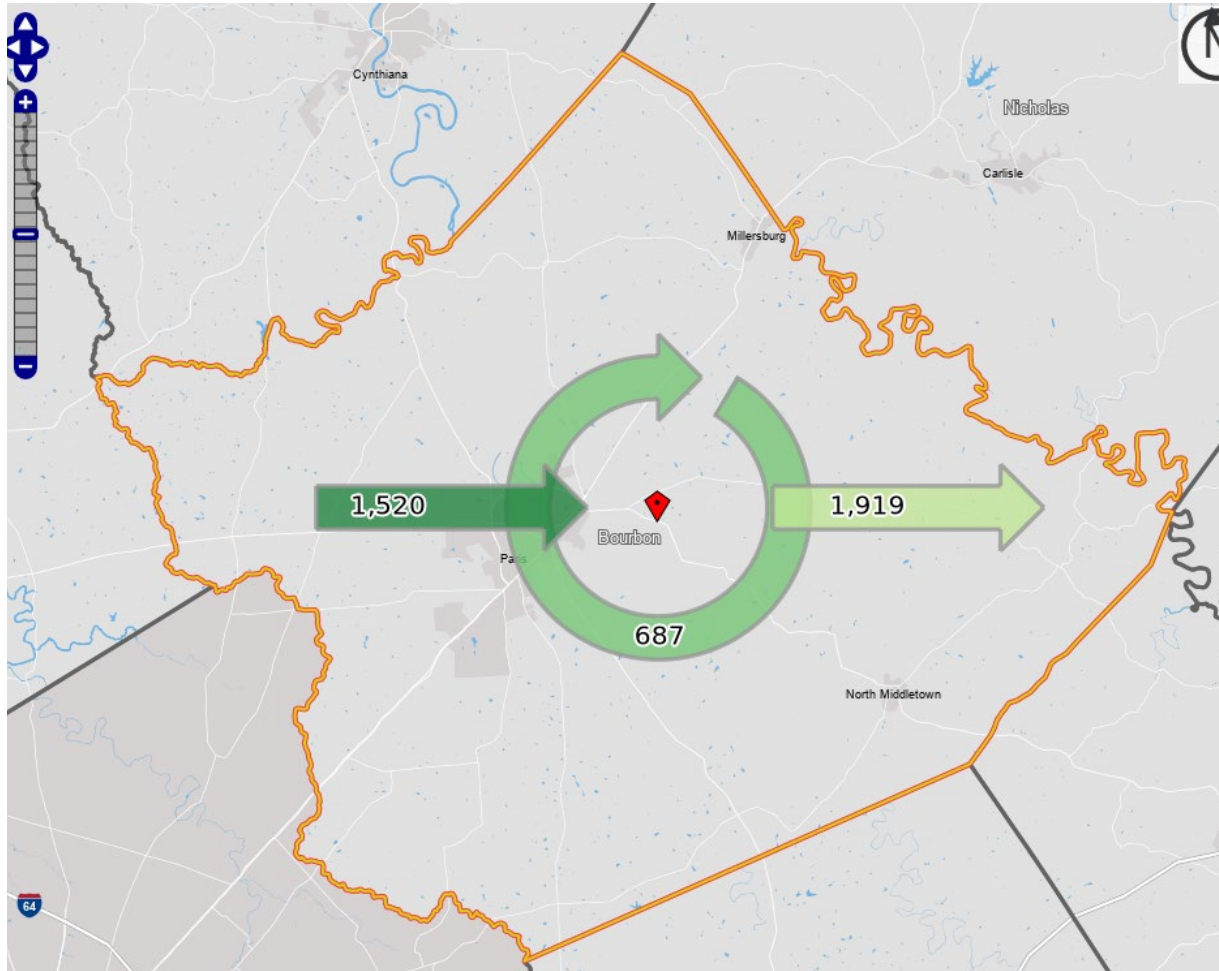
Earnings by Educational Attainment
