



Bourbon County “On the Table” 2019

In April of 2019, almost 200 residents of the Bourbon County community joined together to attend 16 meetings/events to talk about what is important to them. The purpose of these meetings was to learn the priorities of the community as a reference for the Bourbon County Joint Comprehensive Plan update titled “Envision 2040”.

The “On the Table” conversations focused on the following questions:

- What are the biggest strengths of our community?
- What are the biggest challenges that our community faces?
- What actions are crucial for the future success of our community?

Meeting organizers then returned their notes and sign-in sheets, which the Planning Office transcribed and quantified based on keywords.

The graphs to the right provide a generalization of the results for the first two questions. Each working group will also examine the action items recommended by the community while crafting the goals, objectives, and actions for this plan update.
