



HOUSING WORKING GROUP
MEETING 1
SUMMARY OF PROGRESS

The first working group meeting was on May 20, 2019 from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. There were 11 attendees. During this two hour session, we spent the first hour with introductory presentations from Staff and the University of Kentucky. As with all working groups, we talked about the community's perception of housing needs in comparison to what the data tells us. Then, meeting attendees gathered into two groups to craft three draft housing goals. At the end of this breakout session, each group reported out and we came to a consensus on three **draft** housing goals:

- **Expand and ensure a diverse ranges of housing choices.**
- **Support infill and redevelopment within existing infrastructure as a strategic component of growth.**
- **Provide well-designed neighborhoods while demonstrating sensitivity toward natural resource conservation.**

In preparation for the second housing working group meeting, the Planning Office will look-up supplemental information to help educate the working group as they come to a consensus. The goal at the second working group meeting will be to revisit these goals and come to a consensus. The resulting goals will be sent onto the Envision 2040 Advisory Committee for their review.
