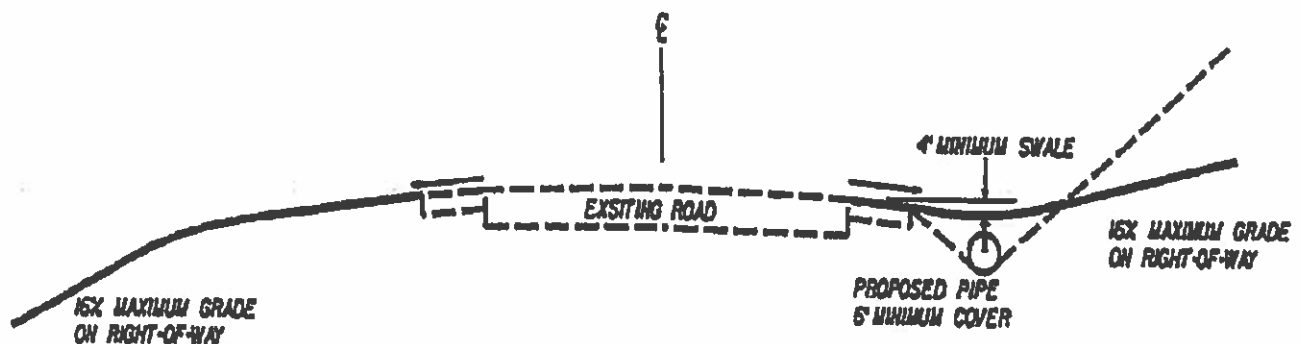
The centerline of the approved entrance is located approximately 514 feet north of the centerline of Harrods Creek Road, which is on the same side of College Road (KY 3364).

The entrance must be constructed so that the water drains away from the road and into the ditch, as shown in the diagram below. If pipe isn't needed and/or there isn't a ditch, the entrance must still drain away from the roadway.
